## DESCRIPTION

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Pair of chairs designed by André Sornay, a key figure in postwar French design, created in the late 1950s.

Each chair features a solid ash frame, assembled with Sornay's patented box joint system. The seats are upholstered in soft cream bouclé fabric, while the veneered backrests add subtle sophistication. The combination of structural clarity and comfort makes this pair both functional and elegant—a refined addition to any interior.
