DESCRIPTION

Solid pine stool with an inverted U-shaped structure, selected for the interior furnishings of the Les Arcs 1800 ski resort in the 1970s.

Crafted from light, durable wood, the stool features a straightforward and functional design that emphasizes material quality and structural clarity. Its simple and stable form reflects the mountain furniture aesthetic developed at Les Arcs, within the context of the furnishings overseen by Charlotte Perriand.
