Description

The Caddy Spoon has a shaped shell bowl and beautiful cast "openwork" handle with bright cut stem and shoulders. The top of the stem is decorated with foliate scrolls and a triple motifs. The reverse of the handle displays a clear set of hallmarks and the contemporary initials EA. Similar examples can be seen in "Caddy Spoons" by Captain John Norie, Plate 2. Length: 3.1 inches, 7.75 cm. Width of the bowl: 1.5 inches, 3.75 cm.
