

A rare George III Taylor "Heart" Caddy spoon made in Birmingham in 1812 by Joseph Taylor.

Description

The caddy spoon is modelled in Joseph Taylor's unusual interpretation of the Heart caddy spoon, with stylised heart shaped bowl, with serrated edge and engraved border of foliate motifs on a prick dot ground.

The centre displays a plain shield shaped motif. The fiddle pattern handle has an angular end and is engraved with foliate motifs, as well as a cartouche engraved with contemporary script initials. This piece is in excellent condition and is very well marked on the reverse. Length: 3 inches, 7.5 cm. Width, across the bowl: 1.6 inches, 4 cm.
