Description

The Scent Flask is plain in design and narrow rectangular in form. The screw on cover is decorated with reeded bands and a corded band at the top. This piece is in excellent condition and is very well marked. These items are especially rare and were probably used when travelling to fill up a more decorative scent etui. Archibald Douglas also made travelling Inkwells of the finest quality.
