Description

The Nutmeg Grater is modelled in the oval form and the sides and base are decorated with crisp bright cut bands. The hinged cover displays a vacant cut cornered cartouche surrounded by floral garlands. This piece is in excellent condition and is very well marked on the cover and on the base. Phipps & Robinson were premier box makers and their work is much sought after.
