Description

The Vinaigrette is broad rectangular in form. The cover, base and sides are decorated with crisp engine turned designs within a plain frame. The cover opens to reveal a finely gilded interior and a very unusual grille, pierced and engraved with a central Satyr's mask, within a laurel frame and flanked by crossed branches and florets. The Vinaigrette is of the finest quality and is very well marked. It is in quite excellent condition.
